

Guidelines for guests with pets

Based on our experience, we have come up with these directions to make sure the guests and pets are safe and happy at Château Coliving.

The pet is the owner's responsibility for the entire duration of their stay at the Château Coliving.

Château Coliving is located on a property with a large outdoor area - it's great for pets to have fun and explore. However, they can get very excited and end up dispersing in the region. That's why we ask our colivers to always be close to their pets when they are away to keep them under your surveillance.

To avoid any kind of inconvenience with other guests and with the furniture, the pet should not be alone in common areas. If the pet is too energetic or causes any inconvenience to other guests, we reserve the right to restrict it from the shared areas. This includes if any guests at this time are afraid or allergic to animals.

To ensure the safest environment for everyone and also for hygiene reasons, we ask that pets do not enter the shared kitchen.

We are surrounded by a natural park and when you go out, your pet can get wet and dirty. We ask that before entering the main building, the pet is cleaned. We do not provide towels for pets.

It is the owner's responsibility to take the animal outside the building regularly and also to clean and dispose of its waste.

To feed your pet, we ask that you do not leave food and water in common areas - you can do that either outside or in your room. There are dishes for food and water for the pet if you need.

On the main staircase, we ask that the small pets are carried by their owners. There is an alternative staircase for large pets. If the pet is shedding a lot of fur, we count on the owner's collaboration to clean carpets and rugs before leaving.

When going out with other people by car, it is recommended to always check if everyone agrees and thinks it is convenient to take the pet for the ride.
