

We are very glad to be able to welcome families with children at the castle together with our more "typical" nomads. We are convinced multigenerational communities are the richest!

Because we want to be able to continue welcoming little ones, we have put together this document for the attention of their parents.

The Chateau is a big place full of bits and bobs, dark and sometimes sharp places, that is also shared with other residents with a lot of work to do.

These guidelines aim to prevent frictions and allow everyone to have a great chateau experience, no matter their age and occupation.

SAFETY

The safety of the children is at all time the responsability of the parent(s). We have steep stairs and some areas in the parks that can be unsafe for children. it is important that children are supervised at all time, or informed of the risks if they are old enough to understand. We kindly ask the parent(s) not to leave any children under the age of 12 unattended at anytime.

~ we welcome initiatives from parents teaming up and taking shifts supervising so there is always at least one responsible adult in charge and other parents can rest, work or explore!

WORKSPACE & EVENTS

The workspace is a dediated space for deep work and we do not accept children in that area. Children are welcome to join our community events, however there might be some specific events, such as skillshares or masterminds that will be "adults only".

NOISE LEVEL

We understand children have a lot of energy and imagination. It is great to see them go on adventure around the property! We also understand that it is sometimes difficult, when it is your own child, to evaluate how loud they actually are. We do want children to be able to play and be children, but it is essential for us that all our residents feel that the castle is a safe and comfortable space where they can work, concentrate and relax in. It is important that we all make sure to be respectful of each other and of the harmony of the Community. Indoor voices are very much encouraged at all time!

DAMAGES

When restauring the castle we took the decision to leave a lot of the ancient and valuable objects in their original place (paintings, antique tables, carpets, vases...) to allow everyone to experience a true castle life.

While children are welcome to spend time in the shared areas, it is very important that they understand there can be no drawing, coloring, painting of any kind that can damage the furniture (unless very closely supervised by an adult), no running inside the castle and if your child is very young, we kindly ask you to pay extra attention to spillage in the shared rooms of the castle. Damages of any kind will have to be covered by the parents.

While this is extremely rare, we would like to mention that if there are any valid and repeated complaints from other guests regarding the children's behavior we reserve the right to restrict certain areas and events.
